



## **EUNIC Fellowship for Cultural Managers 2012**

### ***Call for proposals***

#### **Introduction:**

With the aim of identifying emerging Croatian cultural managers from both the public and private sectors and supporting their engagement with cultural institutions in the EU in a way which will create a lasting impact, the EUNIC Cluster Croatia in cooperation with the Croatian Ministry of Culture invites applications from Croatian citizens for a EUNIC Fellowship for Cultural Managers in 2012.

The aim of the Fellowship is to support a medium-term attachment (1-6 months duration) with a host cultural institution in an EU member state proposed by the applicant. The attachment should be designed so as to produce a lasting productive relationship with the host institution.

#### **Requirements of applications/proposals:**

##### **Selection criteria:**

The following criteria will apply when selecting a fellow:

- a) Applicant should be an emerging Croatian cultural manager from the private or public sector, up to or around 35 years old, who is involved in management/leadership of a cultural activity/institution in Croatia
- b) Application should involve a new link/relationship – not an established link
- c) Attachment should be for a period of no less than one (1) month and no more than six (6) months, to be completed by the end of December 2012
- d) Applicant needs to have the written support of the host institution in an EU member state, demonstrating that this institution is willing to accept the attachment and is prepared to make available staff time and other resources necessary for the attachment to be effective.

e) Applicant needs to demonstrate how the attachment will lead to lasting outcomes for the benefit of both institutions/countries

f) Application needs to include a financial plan with a EUNIC contribution of up to 5,000 Euro.

g) Priority will be given to those applicants who can demonstrate that funding for the attachment will also be provided from other source(s), for example the receiving institution, either in cash or in kind, though this is not a requirement.

The successful EUNIC fellow will be chosen by the EUNIC Selection Committee. Both the fellow and the host institution will need to produce an evaluation report to an agreed format upon completion of the attachment.
